

NSW Building Licence – Building

Overview

The NSW Building Licence course for those pursuing a building licence is based on the completion of the Certificate IV Building and Construction (Building) and Diploma of Building and Construction (Building). On successful completion of this course the delegate will receive a both the Certificate IV Building and Construction (Building) and the Diploma of Building and Construction (Building) which can be used to apply for an NSW Building Licence. (Participants should check their eligibility for a NSW building licence before they enrol. Completion of this program does not guarantee that an individual can obtain a NSW building licence).

This course combines best practice theory with practical examples of workplace application. Transformed's team of experienced facilitators, coaches and assessors have extensive on-the-job experience across a broad range of industries. Structure

Transformed offers flexible training and assessment options which allow participants to fit in their training program around work and other commitments. Transformed offers two flexible learning pathways to enable participants to complete this qualification.

They are:

1. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)/Recognition of Current Competency (RCC) Pathway – this pathway involves assessment only, assessing evidence of existing skills and knowledge against the competency standards.
2. Self-paced study – this pathway requires completion of all units and the associated assessment activities.

The NSW Building Course consists of the Certificate IV Building and Construction (Building) - (16 units) and Diploma of Building and Construction (Building) – (18 units).

Participant Profile

This course is designed to meet the needs of builders overseeing work, its quality and liaising with the client. (Site Supervisors and trainee Site Supervisors). In addition this course can be used to apply for their NSW Building Licence. (Participants should check their eligibility for a NSW building licence before they enrol. Completion of this program does not guarantee that an individual can obtain a NSW building licence).

Duration - Self-paced study over a twelve (12) month period.

Prerequisites

Whilst there are no formal pre-requisites for this program, experience in the building and construction industry as well as a basic knowledge of the BCA and other standards.

Assessment Participants are required to undertake a number of assessment activities, including:

- Self-assessment
- Completion of assessment tasks

Assessment is against the competency standards within the Construction Training Package (CPC08). Participants can expect to spend about 200 hours undertaking assessment tasks.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Assessment via interview and portfolio of evidence is available to participants with relevant workplace experience. Transformed will provide participants seeking RPL a detailed RPL kit to assist them in preparing their evidence for assessment.
