

WA Building Practitioner Registration

Overview

In order to be registered as a Building Practitioner in Western Australia the guidelines are as follows:

Individuals who do not wish to contract directly with others to provide building work valued over \$20,000 or who will not be seeking a building permit from a local government do not need to be registered. However, persons who wish to be the 'nominated supervisor' of a 'building contractor' must be registered as a 'building practitioner'.

Persons who have qualifications and experience that would enable them to obtain registration, but do not necessarily require registration to carry out their work, for example an employee of a building company or an independent building inspector, may choose to apply for registration as a 'building practitioner'.

This course can be used to meet the requirements in applying for registration as a WA Building Practitioner (plus seven years relevant experience). However there are several pathways towards achieving the WA Building Practitioner Registration via qualifications and experience.

Learning Outcomes

Program Duration

It is expected that participants in this program will complete their qualification within a twelve month period.

Prerequisites

For the Diploma there are no formal pre-requisites, experience in the building and construction industry as well as a basic knowledge of the BCA and other standards is desirable. In addition this course can be used to apply for WA Building Practitioner Registration along with other Set 1 guidelines noted on the Building Commission WA website (including seven years relevant experience).

(Participants should check their eligibility for WA Building Practitioner Registration before they enrol. Completion of this program does not guarantee that an individual can obtain WA Building Registration).

Assessment

Participants are required to undertake a number of assessment activities, including:

- Self-assessment
- Completion of assessment tasks

Assessment is against the competency standards within the Construction Training Package (CPC08). Participants can expect to spend about 200 hours undertaking assessment tasks.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Assessment via interview and portfolio of evidence is available to participants with relevant workplace experience in a building and construction environment. Transformed will provide participants seeking RPL a detailed RPL kit to assist them in preparing their evidence for assessment.
